Shirley Ryan AbilityLab also funds numerous community benefits for multiple underserved populations — benefits that would not exist without Shirley Ryan AbilityLab's support. Initiatives include LIFE Center education and outreach; an adaptive sports program, which is comprised of recreational and competitive sports programming for children and adults, sports and fitness center programming, and military sports programming; patient peer support groups; education for healthcare providers; and innovative medical research.
